ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE POSITION: The Elementary Math

Teacher/Intervention teacher is responsible for teaching two elementary math classes and supporting students in math or reading intervention in 1:1 or small group settings. Implements math strategies to enable students to develop the competencies and skills to be successful in math. Identifies student needs through pre- and post-assessments. Provides small group instruction designed to motivate and meet the individual needs of students. Establishes and maintains standards of classroom management required to achieve effective participation in all activities. Evaluates academic growth of students through administering pre- and post-assessments and tracking weekly progress. Communicates student progress with teachers, curriculum specialists and administrators to help guide intervention and classroom instruction for individual students.
